Mooks Clothing and RESISTcrew announce Resist 2006 Melbourne, opening at Brightspace gallery on February 17th. Resist 2006 will transcend the boundaries of established artistic disciplines by encouraging exhibiting artists to 'remix' each others work into fresh and dynamic new pieces.

Featuring the works of 26 Australian and international artists including Jeremyville, Phibs, Yok, Reka, Mephisto Jones and Meek, Resist 2006 will cross the boundaries between street art, design, fine art, illustration, sculpture and new media.

Resist 2006 Melbourne will feature artworks created with the idea of the 'remix' in mind. All Resist artists must develop a piece based on the work of another exhibiting artist, forcing those involved to use mediums, themes and imagery unfamiliar to their everyday practice.

'Remixed' works being exhibited include graffiti characters transformed into sculptural installations and prominent stencils from the streets of Melbourne re-created as tapestries.

RESIST events have been previously staged in Sydney, the UK and New Zealand. Each of these events has attracted large crowds, highlighting an ever-growing enthusiasm for art forms such as graffiti and street-art.
